LETTER FROM THE CEO

For nearly 13 years, Fuck Cancer has done things differently to help our community on their best and worst days. This support resonated personally this year when my mother passed away after living with cancer for 30 years. We were incredibly lucky that she had amazing access to physicians, treatments, and her family and friends' support and advocacy. Unfortunately, this is not the case for everyone.

Socioeconomic factors, including race, income, and location, deeply impact cancer risk and outcomes. Just one of these, your zip code, can determine up to 60% of your health outcomes. Where you live impacts your exposure to pollution and your access to healthy foods, green space, and medical care. Because of this, Fuck Cancer focuses on advancing health equity through early detection and prevention programs, and by providing resources to navigate, manage, and cope with cancer. Our work on early detection and prevention was even more critical this year as the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic resulted in missed routine cancer screenings, leading to delayed diagnoses. To address this head-on, we have ramped up our programs in high-risk communities to provide additional vaccines to prevent cancer and increased screenings to find breast, cervical, colorectal, and lung cancers early when they are easiest to treat.

While my mom's cancer could not have been helped by these interventions, I know how fortunate we were to have access to amazing treatment and support services. At Fuck Cancer, we hope to do the same for our community.

Whether you're a patient, caregiver, survivor, or supporter, we've all been affected by cancer. Thank you for being part of the Fuck Cancer community.




More than 40% of cancer diagnoses could be prevented. Because of this, we work with community clinics and high schools to prevent cancer before it can even start.





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EARLY DETECTION

Most cancers are curable when caught in Stage One. That's why we partner with clinics in high-risk communities to provide free and low-cost cancer screenings.








