PICK UP YOUR POOP



Your dog wants you to pick up your poop.

Colon cancer is on the rise in Americans under 50, but if you find it early, it can be easier to treat. Besides – you're already comfortable with your dog's poop, so why not your own? As part of the Pick Up Your Poop campaign, we built an AI tool to create personalized videos urging your loved ones to get screened for colorectal cancer — starring their favorite four-legged friends. The campaign was recognized globally, winning Bronze in the Pharma category at Cannes Lions 2025.

SKIN CANCER EARLY NFTFCTION



Motorsports + Beauty Salons = Early Detection Champions

This year, we teamed up with Team Truck Melanoma and The Closer Look Project to bring skin cancer early detection to even more communities. Through our work with Team Truck Melanoma, we're providing education and skin screenings at motorsports events. With The Closer Look Project, we're helping to train beauty and personal care professionals how to spot suspicious moles on their clients and connect them with follow-up healthcare.

MARK OF LIFE



Redefining marks of survival into symbols of inspiration.

It's common for cancer patients to receive a tattoo during radiation therapy to more precisely aim treatments. These markers are part of potentially life-saving measures, but they can also be a painful reminder of cancer. The Mark of Life campaign helped connect survivors with talented tattoo artists to turn their radiation markers into a symbol of hope and optimism.

P.INK Angel fund



Reclaiming your body after breast cancer.

Expanding our incredibly successful Personal Ink program, we launched the P.ink Angel Fund this year to fill the gap for breast cancer survivors who are ineligible for P.ink Days, but are looking for closure through art. By connecting individual recipients with trusted artists to get a free tattoo to cover lumpectomy scars, port scars, or male mastectomy scars, the Angel Fund aims to provide healing to all breast cancer survivors.

PREFERENCE IS POSSIBLE!

Almost 40,000 people are diagnosed with HPV-associated cancers every year in the U.S.

The HPV vaccine is one of only vaccines available to prevent cancer, and it's capable of preventing more than 90% of cancers that are associated with HPV. Unfortunately, many people haven't heard of the vaccine or haven't gotten it, and are therefore unprotected. We offer programs in California and Oklahoma to increase HPV vaccination rates among 9-25 year olds. Together, we are lowering cancer risk among these populations.




PERSONAL MANAGEMENT OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PRO

MARK OF LIFE


